- One Giant or Large Dahlia and Three Distinct Vases of 3 Dahlias choosing from Classes 10, 11, 12, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22 or 23. One Variety per Vase and only 1 Vase from any of the above Classes**
- Class 2. Four Vases, Three Blooms of Dahlias, One Variety to a Vase**
- Class 3. Two Vases, Three Blooms of Dahlias, One Vase of Small Cactus or Semi Cactus and One Vase of Small Decorative, One Variety per Vase**
- Class 4. Two Vases, Three Blooms of Dahlias, Medium Cactus or Semi Cactus. Two Varieties, One Variety per Vase**
- Class 5. Two Vases, Three Blooms of Dahlias, Miniature Decorative. Two Varieties, One Variety per Vase**
- Class 6. Six Giant Decorative Dahlias, in Separate Vases**
- Class 7. Three Giant Decorative Dahlias, in Separate Vases**
- Class 8. One Vase, One Giant Decorative Dahlia**
- Class 9. One Vase, Three Large Decorative Dahlias**
- Class 10. One Vase, Three Medium Decorative Dahlias**
- Class 11. One Vase, Three Small Decorative Dahlias**
- Class 12. One Vase, Three Miniature Decorative Dahlias**
- Class 13. Three Giant Cactus or Semi Cactus Dahlias, in Separate Vases**
- Class 14. One Vase, One Giant Cactus or Semi Cactus Dahlia**
- Class 15. One Vase, Three Large Cactus or Semi Cactus Dahlias**
- Class 16. One Vase, Three Medium Cactus or Semi Cactus Dahlias**
- Class 17. One Vase, Three Small or Miniature Cactus or Semi Cactus Dahlias**

- Class 18. One Vase, Three Small or Miniature Cactus or Semi Cactus Dahlias. Excluding Kiwi Gloria and Sports**
- Class 19. One Vase, Three Small Ball Dahlias**
- Class 20. One Vase, Three Miniature Ball Dahlias**
- Class 21. One Vase, Five Pompon Dahlias**
- Class 22. One Vase, Three Large Pompon Dahlias**
- Class 23. One Vase, Three Waterlily Dahlias**
- Class 24. One Vase, Three Collerette Dahlias**
- Class 25. One Vase, Three Miniature Dahlias, must be three separate varieties**
- Class 26. One Vase, Containing One Dahlia Bloom.
Entries restricted to not more than two vases per exhibitor**
- Class 27. Seedling or Sport - One Vase, One Bloom
Giant or Large Dahlia or One Vase, Three Blooms Medium, Small, Miniature or Pompon Dahlias. Which are not in commerce**
- Class 28. One Vase, Three Blooms of Dahlias, Three Varieties One Classification**
- Class 29. A Display of not less than Twelve Dahlias arranged and judged 50% for frontal effect and 50% for quality of blooms, with no artificial support, MUST contain other plant foliage, own container allowed. The N.D.S. size rules do not apply**
- Class 30. For Exhibitors who have not won a class in any previous NEDA Show. One Vase, Three Blooms of Dahlias, Any Classification**

SPECIAL AWARDS

- The N.D.S. Silver Medal and N.E.D.A. Shield for Best Exhibit in Show**
- The STOCKSBRIDGE AWARD and N.D.S. Bronze Medal for Best Vase of Cactus or Semi Cactus Dahlia in Show**
- The OSCROFT AWARD and N.D.S. Bronze Medal for Best Vase of Decorative, Ball, pompon, Waterlily or Collerette Dahlia in Show**
- The GERARAD PETERS AWARD for Most Points in Show**
- The ARMITAGE AWARD for Best Newcomer in Show**

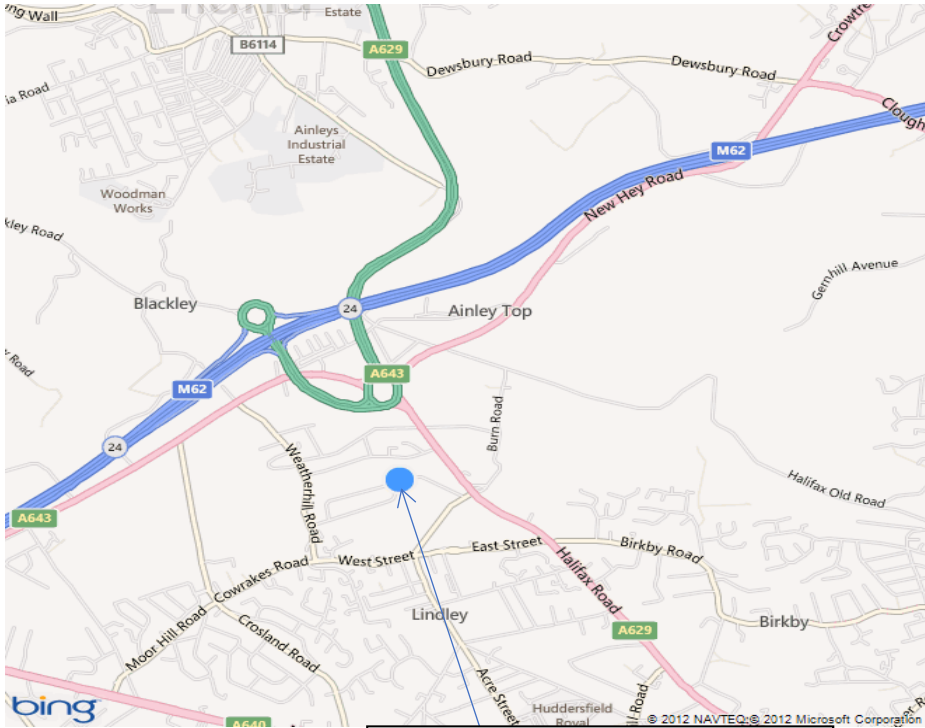

SHOW RULES

- 1. Staging will be on Show day. Vasing from 7.30am. Staging from 8.30am to 11.45am. Entries taken up to 11.30am. Entry forms from Show Secretary.**
- 2. All varieties to be named on the cards provided except Classes 27 and 29.**
- 3. The Society will not be responsible for any damage to the property of the Exhibitor, but normal care will be taken.**
- 4. The Hall will be cleared at 11.45am. At the discretion of the Show Manager for judging.**
- 5. The decision of the Judges on the merits of the Exhibits will be final.**
- 6. The Points awarded shall be as follows:

Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 28. 1st 5, 2nd 3 and 3rd 2 points.

All other classes 1st 3, 2nd 2 and 3rd 1 points.**
- 7. The Show Manager reserves the right to refuse any entries.**
- 8. Anyone objecting to an award should do so in writing to the Show Secretary before 2.30pm. Whose decision will be final.**
- 9. All Exhibit's will be judged to N.D.S. Rules except Class 29.**
- 10. All seedlings and sports exhibited shall be in the name of the Raiser.**
