Cultivars may only be submitted with the explicit consent of the raiser. All cultivars are sent at the risk of the raiser or sender. If you require the return of your cultivar(s), you will be responsible for any applicable postage and packing charges. Each cultivar must be named and clearly labelled. Six plants of each cultivar should be provided; the best four will be selected for planting, up to a maximum of four different varieties per entrant. Additional entries may be considered at the discretion of the committee. All sports must be accompanied by their parent cultivar. Please note that the preferred plant height is between 100 mm and 250 mm (4–10 inches).

Cultivars must not have been in commercial distribution for more than 18 months, subject to the committee's discretion. Plants must be free from pests and diseases. Where possible, please provide a photograph of the plant in bloom.

Entries should be submitted to Mr. A. Cunningham, 3 Sandringham Road, Clayton, Bradford, BD14 6EA. The closing date for entries is 26 May 2026. Planting out will take place on **TUESDAY, 2nd June 2026**, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.
